
The WyldeChild brings together two iconic circuits—the BRIT-800 and the Analog Chorus—to deliver the unmistakable metal tones of the '90s, famously associated with Zakk Wylde and other legendary guitarists. The BRIT-800 provides the powerful, saturated distortion that defined that era's heavy sound, while the Analog Chorus adds depth and warmth, recreating the lush, swirling modulation that complements high-gain tones. This combination features order switching for two different chorus tones when used in tandem.

The BRIT-800 is inspired by the Marshall circuit they designed to emulate their legendary JCM800 amplifier that defined an era. This circuit offers a wide range of saturated distortion and hot-rodded British tones, all with precise control over Level, Gain, Bass, Middle, and Treble—perfect for shaping your own distinctive sound.

The Analog Chorus inspired by the BOSS® CE-2 Chorus Ensemble captures the essence of the original pedal, famously used by David Gilmour and Eric Clapton. Renowned for its warm, rich analog chorus sound, it offers a milder modulation compared to its predecessor, the CE-1, ensuring the guitar tone remains sharp and well-defined. With just two knobs—Rate and Depth—it's simple to operate but provides captivating chorus effects, from subtle ambiance to lush modulation that works extremely well in tandem with distortion.

Key Features:

- Classic 90s Metal Tones: The BRIT-800 distortion delivers the saturated, high-gain tones synonymous with Zakk Wylde's signature sound, perfect for modern metal riffs and solos.
- Dual Chorus Options: Featuring order switching, this setup allows for two distinct Analog Chorus tones—one with subtle
 modulation and the other with a more pronounced, lush chorus effect to complement the distortion.




Order switching is built-in, with Ribbon Cable connections making wiring a breeze.



Important: Only use a 9-volt negative tip power supply to avoid damage.

- You need a 3PDT On-On toggle switch (Order)
- D1 D2 suggest 1N914 however you may try other diodes like 1N4148.
- D3 requires a 1N1N4739 9.1v Zener diode or similar Zener. <u>Do not substitute</u>.
- IC2 requires a V3207D chip. You may try an MN3207 but it is not recommended unless you are certain it is authentic and works.
- IC3 requires a V3102D chip. The same applies here as well.
- IC4 requires a TL022 chip. Do not substitute. This is not a typo.



Build Notes:


1. There are two (CLR) Current Limiting Resistors crucial to protect and adjust the brightness of their corresponding status LED. You may use a value of 1k8 (Bright) to 4k7 (Dim).




Easy Wiring Diagram
